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Entry-to-Practice Competencies for RNs



Uses information and communication technologies (ICT) to support information synthesis in accordance with professional and regulatory standards in the delivery of patient/client care:

- Uses relevant information and knowledge to support the delivery of evidence informed patient care.
- Uses ICTs in accordance with professional and regulatory standards and workplace policies.
- 3. Uses information and communication technologies in the delivery of patient/client care.

Indicators (a few examples):

- 1. Analyses, interprets, and documents pertinent nursing data and patient data using standardized nursing and other clinical terminologies to support clinical decision making and nursing practice improvements.
- 2. Identifies and reports system process and functional issues according to organizational policies and procedures.
- 3. Uses decision support tools to assist clinical judgment and safe patient care.

- To establish Faculty Peer Leader Networks to provide mentorship, engagement and influence culture change related to the effective use of ICTs and Consumer Health technologies in clinical practice through innovative teaching strategies
