
ConnectingGTA will **improve** the patient and clinician experience by **delivering** a regional electronic health record for **6.75 million individuals**

ConnectingGTA is a hub that connects health service provider information systems as well as regional and provincial registries and repositories

ConnectingGTA – By the Numbers



~2.4 million patients captured (36% of the region's population)*



~106 million messages captured

50% identified regional acute information captured
100% identified regional CCAC information captured
75% provincial lab results captured



∼40 Early adopter organizations(17 organizations populating the CDR)

The ConnectingGTA Approach – Design Principles


Driven by clinicians and clinical priorities across the care continuum




- Information to be shared seamlessly & securely

- Robust, scalable & reusable platform



- Connecting Northern & Eastern Ontario

Platform for Innovation

- The ConnectingGTA Portal is the first web application to build upon this platform, but is only one method to get access to this data
- This platform provides the flexibility to build new applications faster with minimal rework and leveraging the Back End infrastructure
 - Could be built on any platform (such as web applications or portlets)
 - Fully integrated within a hospital information system
 - Accessible on any mobile device
